NUTCRACKER COSTUME REQUIREMENTS

Nutcracker of Middle Georgia provides **ALL** costumes; however, you will need to furnish your own items as listed below:

Angels: nude camisole leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes

Cavalry: black ballet or jazz shoes, black tights

Clara: black leather ballet shoes w/pink elastic, Capezio mesh transition tights (CLP), pale pink camisole leotard, and pointe shoes

Columbine: nude camisole leotard, Capezio mesh transition tights (CLP), and pointe shoes

Dragon: black leather ballet shoes with white elastic, white tights, or socks

Fritz and Little Boys: black jazz shoes, dark t-shirt

Harlequin: white or nude camisole leotard (female), white leotard (male), white tights, and black leather ballet shoes

Heralds: nude camisole leotard, white leather ballet shoes with white elastic (So Danca split sole), white tights

Jack-in-the-Box & Jesters: white leather ballet shoes with white elastic (So Danca split sole), white tights

Ladies and Soldiers' Date: black hose, black character shoes

Little Girls: nude camisole leotard, black leather ballet shoes with pink elastic (So Danca black leather split sole), Capezio mesh transition tights (CLP)

Maids: nude camisole leotard, black hose, and black character shoes

Men & Young Soldier: white dress shirt and black jazz shoes

Mice: pink leather ballet shoes with pink elastic

Toy Soldiers: black leather ballet or jazz shoes, white tights, black crew socks

Snow, Flowers, Marzipan, Spanish, Chinese: nude camisole leotard, Capezio mesh transition tights (CLP), and pointe shoes

IF A NUDE LEOTARD IS REQUIRED FOR YOUR COSTUME, IT MUST BE WORN FOR EACH AND EVERY PERFORMANCE. BOBO'S DANCE SUPPLY ON INGLESIDE AVENUE IN MACON CAN PROVIDE YOU WITH ALL OF YOUR NUTCRACKER COSTUME REQUIREMENTS. PLEASE VISIT THEM AS SOON AS POSSIBLE IN CASE YOUR ITEMS NEED TO BE ORDERED.

This will allow you to make the necessary adjustments to your schedule to avoid any conflicts with "Nutcracker" rehearsals, fittings, and performances, should you be cast.

Please understand clearly that a CAST MEMBER WILL BE REPLACED if they cannot attend **ALL** rehearsals, fittings, and performances as scheduled. It is impossible to offer the public a quality production if we must work around someone's **TARDINESS OR ABSENCE** during rehearsals.

The performance held on **Wednesday, December 6 at 10:00 AM** is offered to area school children. This will necessitate absences from school or work. Therefore, we will provide written documentation to schools and employers.

Our "Nutcracker" production is a very comprehensive undertaking. Each year, there are many questions and concerns from the cast and parents. To clarify those concerns and to solicit your help as a volunteer, a **mandatory meeting** for all cast members and their parents will be held on **Sunday, September 24th at 2:30 PM at Northway Church located at 5915 Zebulon Road.** (If you are new to Nutcracker of Middle Georgia, please arrive at **2:00 PM.**) **It is imperative that everyone attend.**


